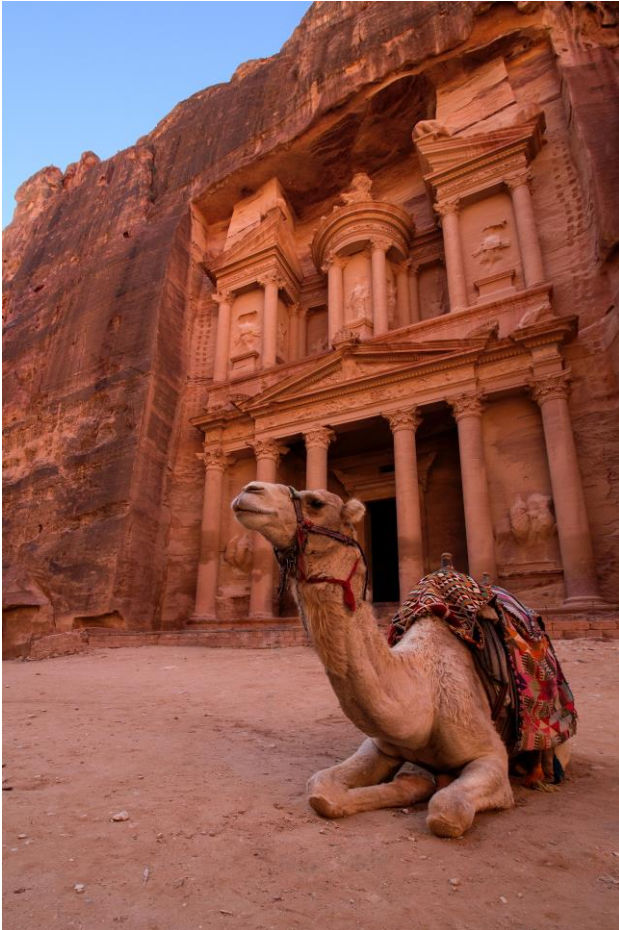


Tour to Jordan

Itinerary as follows:

Day 1: Flight to Amman.

- Arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, Amman at 11:20 am.
- We will be greeted by the in Amman and transfer to hotel.
- Check in at hotel.
- Dinner in hotel.
- Overnight in hotel.

Day 2: Full Day Excursion of Amman.

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Full day excursion of Amman. Sights include:
 - Amman Citadel.
 - Roman theatre.
 - Archeological & Folkloric Museum.
- Lunch in a local restaurant.
- Visit of the Cave of 7 Sleepers and the tomb of Hazrat Shoaib (R.A).
- Dinner in hotel.
- Overnight in hotel.

Day 3: Amman-Jerash-Ajloun-Amman.

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Transfer to visit the Roman City of Jerash. It is one of the 10 Decapolis cities in the old Roman Empire and one of the best-preserved roman cities in the world.
- Transfer to Ajloun Castle which was built in 1184 by Izz ad-Din Usama bin Munqidh, a general of Saladin, who defeated the Crusaders in 1187. It's a fine example of Islamic architecture; the fortress dominated a wide stretch of the northern Jordan Valley and passages to it.
- Lunch in a local restaurant.
- Transfer to Amman.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Overnight in hotel.

Day 4: Amman-Madaba-Nebo-Karak-Wadi Rum.

1. Breakfast at hotel.
2. Transfer to visit Madaba, “the City of Mosaics.” The city, best known for its spectacular Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics, is home to the famous 6th century mosaic map of Jerusalem and the Holy Land.
3. Transfer to historic Mount Nebo, one of the most revered holy sites of Jordan and the place where Moses was buried. A small Byzantine church was built there by early Christians.
4. Lunch at local restaurant.
5. Transfer to Wadi Rum.
6. Dinner at Wadi Rum.
7. Overnight in Wadi Rum.

Day 5: Wadi Rum-Petra-Amman.

- Breakfast.
- Transfer to Petra for whole day. Sights include:
 - The Rose Red city “Petra” the world wonder, which is Jordan’s most valuable treasure and greatest tourist attraction. It is a vast, unique city, carved into the sheer rock face by the Nabataea’s, an industrious Arab people who settled here more than 2000 years ago, turning it into an important junction for the silk, spice and other trade routes that linked China, India and southern Arabia with Egypt, Syria, Greece and Rome.
 - Horseback ride of Siq.
 - Visit of the Treasury,
 - Visit of the Roman Theater,
 - Visit of the Royal Tombs and Court,
 - Visit of Qaser Al Bint and the Church.
- Lunch at a local restaurant.
- Transfer to Amman.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Overnight in hotel.

Day 6: Amman-Baptism-Dead Sea.

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Visit of the baptism site where Jesus was baptized.
- Transfer to Dead Sea, one of the lowest points on earth 400 meters below sea level, and one of the most spectacular natural and spiritual landscapes in the world.
- Lunch at hotel.
- Leisure time.
- Dinner at hotel.
- Overnight in hotel.

Day 7: Dead Sea-Amman-Departure.

1. Breakfast at hotel.
2. Transfer to Amman.
3. Transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for flight to Pakistan.
